Baler's audit that operates throughout the year (approximately 1,296 m) for the crops described in the scope. The process only involves immersion (not recirculated water) for the case of the bean and drying with centrifuge. The process for bean consists of reception, weighing, storage / pre-cooling (37-40 ° F), immersion in antimicrobial or PC (free chlorine 100ppm, pH is not monitored, water comes from 1 well), centrifuge, sorting, bagging, heavy, entry to plastic boxes, labeling, entry to refrigerator (37-40 ° F) and refrigerated container loading (this step was not observed). The process of Arveja is similar to that of Ejote only without washing. The process observed for Elotín consists of reception, sorting, removal of tusso, cutting, bagging, weighing, entry into plastic boxes, labeling, entry into the refrigerator (37-40 ° F) and loading in a refrigerated container (this step was not observed). There are 2 refrigerators in place, it presents a team such as stainless steel tables, centrifuge, centrifuge. The pest control system is in charge of the company Multiexterminadora and is based on bait traps (external) sticks legs (internal). On site workers with PPE consisting of hairnets, green coat and gabacha (no gloves are used), an amount of 115 workers on site. Finally we proceeded to review thecumentation and cross information against what is evaluated on site: training, POEs, policies, etc.NOTE. The pumpkin was only observed in cold room, no process is observed.
